



Interchange Agreement

Goulburn Valley League & Kyabram District League

This Interchange Agreement template is intended for use exclusively in situations where both football controlling bodies (Leagues) involved are AFL Victoria Country Affiliate Leagues. It is consistent with Clause 2.4 of the AFL Victoria Country Rules and Section 3.7(a) of the National Community Football Policy Handbook.

Executed Interchange Agreements must be submitted to AFL Victoria Football Operations Manager Joel Lovett – joel.lovett@afl.com.au for final approval within ten (10) calendar days of its execution, before being loaded into the competition management platform (PlayHQ).

An Agreement between the Goulburn Valley League & Kyabram District League.

This agreement is signed pursuant to AFL Victoria Country rules and regulations pertaining to permits and in particular Clause 2.4 – Interchange (Area) Agreements, whereby an interchange of players between clubs of the abovementioned Leagues may take place without a transfer and is subject to any provisions contained within this agreement.

Interchange Agreements are ongoing from year to year unless revoked by one of the football bodies party to the agreement by advising AFL Victoria.

PROVIDED HOWEVER:

- (i) That this permit is in force for the current season only.
- (ii) Prior to each match the player shall obtain permission electronically from their parent club using a Season permit.
- (iv) Players of any club having a bye will not be allowed to play with another club on that day unless they have previously played with that club in the current season under this agreement. The club playing the player from the other League shall show their registered club on the match team sheet. Players of third 18 teams of Senior Grade competitions are not to be classified as players of Junior age competitions.
- (v) A local interchange agreement can override clause (iv) to restrict junior players playing on permit when their club has a bye.
- (vi) That this agreement cannot be altered unless agreed to by the Region Manager.
- (vii) as per GVL by-laws, players are ineligible to play finals on permit.

LOCAL CONDITIONS:

1. AGREEMENT

- The Agreement shall remain valid and current unless altered and then endorsed by the Regional Manager. No alterations may be made to this agreement without approval from both leagues included.

2. INTERCHANGE OF PLAYERS

Major League players are permitted six (6) permits to play in the District League H&A Thirds (U18) Grade

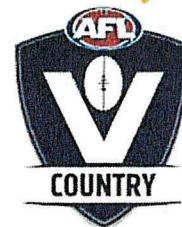
- The total number of permits must not exceed six (6).
- Permits are not permitted for senior or reserve grade. GVL players are permitted to play in the KDL on permit when their home club has a BYE (this includes General League BYES)

District league players are permitted six (6) permits to play in the Major League H&A THIRDS (U18) grade provided:

- The total number of permits must not exceed six (6).
- KDL are permitted to play in the GVL Thirds on permit when their home club has a BYE (this includes General League BYES)

District league players are permitted 4 permits to play in the Major League Seconds (Reserves) grade provided:

- The total number of permits must not exceed four (4).



3. FINALS PERMITS & ELIGIBILITY

- NO permits are issued to play finals in either League.

4. GAMES PER DAY/WEEKEND

- Players permitted to **ONLY PLAY ONE (1)** game per weekend.

5. NUMBER OF PERMITS

- District/Major League Thirds (U18) – Teams are only permitted **six (6)** permit players in any one match.
- Major League Reserves – Teams are only permitted **four (4)** permit players in any one match.

6. REPORTED PLAYERS

- A player playing on permit that is reported shall face the Tribunal of the League of which the offence was committed. Any penalty that is imposed shall apply in all competitions.

7. PERMIT BREACHES

Any breach of Permit arrangements and agreements will be referred to the AFL Victoria Country Rule 1.1 – Penalty for playing ineligible or unregistered players

8. SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

- Clubs are reminded to abide by local league by-laws that may be in place in regards to number of permits permitted arrangements i.e. overage/medical etc.
- KDL are permitted to play in the GVL Thirds on permit when their home club has a BYE (this includes General League BYES)
- GVL are permitted to play in KDL Thirds on permit when their home club has a BYE (this includes General League BYES)
